

GENERAL INFORMATION

All ATA and Club Safety Rules apply at this shoot. The Handicap Committee will classify shooters at the time of registration.

Ties will be shot of as soon as possible. Failure to report to the firing line 5 minutes after the first call will result in forfeiture.

Purse participation is not compulsory.

Decision of the referees shall be final. Check your scores according to ATA Rules. Management reserves the right to reject or disqualify any contestant who, in their judgment, interferes with the harmony of the shoot or violates ATA Rules and Regulations. Only one trophy/prize will be awarded to any one shooter in the same event. When the shooter qualifies for more than one award in one event the shooter must notify the shoot director which trophy they will accept.

One ATA fee of \$2.00 and one GATA fee of \$2.00 will be paid once daily, total \$4.00. Shells are available at the clubhouse.

The PERFECT (Middle) 50 purse grows as shooters contribute to it. It is paid out at 60% to the first shooter that breaks the middle 50 in the handicap event. The remaining 40% is rolled over into the next middle 50 purse. If no one breaks the Perfect 50 at this shoot, the money rolls over into the next shoot and increases the purse. Shooters who choose to participate in the Perfect 50 purse must have 500 handicap targets total for their assigned yardage or will shoot from the 23 yard line. Handicap targets will be shot on 1 to 4 fields as determined by shoot management and depending on the number of shooters.

All winners will be mailed their winnings within 10 days of the shoot.

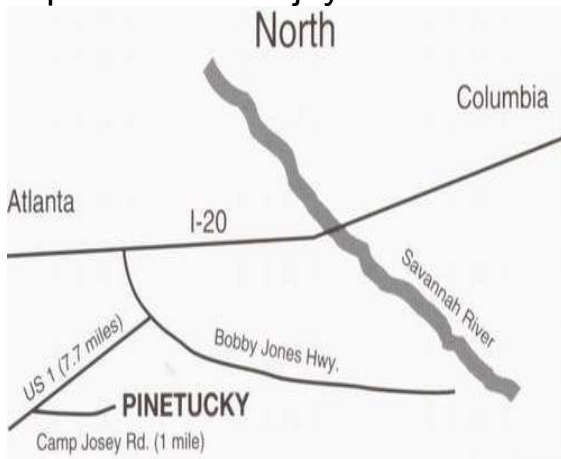
